

DATA PROTECTION STATEMENT FOR VISITORS

Purpose and legal basis of the data processing (GDPR Art. 13(1)(c))

- Visitor data collection: ensuring access control and the undisturbed possession of premises, for the tracking of safety violations and for the safety of visitors in the event of a fire (GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)*)
- Visitor badge: safety measure in the context of access control, identification as authorised external visitor (GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)*)
- Aggregation of data in anonymous statistics for tracking visitor numbers (statistical purposes) (GDPR Art. 6(1)(f)**)

Interests of the controller when weighing up interests (GDPR Art. 13(1)(d))

*The data processing is based on the interest in limiting access to the controllers' business premises to legitimate and authorised visitors in order to implement the legal requirements regarding effective and traceable access control. The data will also be used to track any safety violations committed by visitors.
In addition, the data will be used in the event of a fire in order to identify any persons present or missing and to pass this information to the emergency services.

**Aggregating the data into an anonymous number serves the interest to obtain a typical number of visitors for a given time period.

Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data (GDPR Art. 12(1)(e))

Affiliated companies, waste disposal service providers, law enforcement agencies in case of criminal acts, fire departments in case of fire

Data transmission to third countries (point (f) of Art. 13(1) GDPR Art. 13(1)(f))

No data is transferred to third countries.

Storage period in accordance with statutory retention requirements (GDPR Art. 13(2)(a))

Personal data will typically be erased from our visitor data collection system within 90 days following the end of the visit.

Visitor badges are destroyed immediately after the end of the visit.

Right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction, data portability and objection (GDPR Art. 13(2)(b))

As data subject you have the right at any time to request access to your data, rectification and erasure of your data, and restriction of processing, as well as a right to data portability. In order to exercise these rights, please contact the controller using the contact details provided.

Right to object (GDPR Art. 21(1))

Insofar as the processing of your data is carried out to protect legitimate interests, you have the right to object to this processing at any time using the contact details provided if reasons arise from your particular situation that conflict with this data processing. We will then cease such processing unless it serves compelling legitimate interests on our part.

Right to lodge a complaint (GDPR Art. 13(2)(d))

As a data subject, you can contact the responsible State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information in Baden-Württemberg at any time if you have any complaints.

Existence of a requirement to provide personal data (GDPR Art. 13(2)(e))

The first and last name must always be provided for the purpose of identifying the visitor. Without these details, no access can be granted to the controller's premises.
